Following her move to London, while working in architectural practice for 6 years, Sam completed a Post graduate diploma in Practice Management at the Bartlett School of Architecture and gained her ARB accreditation. Sam re-located to

Manchester in 2019 and became a freelance architect in the private housing sector, designing bespoke new builds and house extensions, before returning to practice at Hodder + Partners.

Whilst working in practice in London, Sam gained extensive experience in the delivery of high profile, large scale, high-rise mixed residential schemes across the capital.

More recently, Sam has been co-leading on the delivery of the Haymarket project, a PBSA and Co-Living scheme in Bristol.
